Commission 7 has finished a very successful 4 years period. The official handover of commissions chairmanship for the years 2007-2010 took place during the FIG Congress in Munich.

Once again, on behalf of Commission 7, as the new chair, I would like thanks again for the outgoing chair, Prof. Paul van der Molen for his outstanding performance and his team Christiaan Lemmen and Pauline van Elsland for all of their efforts and excellent achievements.

I hope Commission 7 family will continue its successful work in the future, expecting your usual support and contribution. I try my best together with Mr. Gyula Iván vice chair administration and Mrs. Mária Tóth secretary to keep Commission 7 active and successful.

1. XIIIth FIG Congress in Munich, Germany, October 8-13, 2006. "Shaping the Change":

1.1 Major Decisions of the General Assembly:

- Prof. **Stig Enemark** from Denmark was elected as the new President of FIG for the period 2007-2010.
- Mr. Matt Higgins (Australia) and Dr. Dalal S. Alnaggar (Egypt) were elected as Vice Presidents for 2007-2010.
- Prof. **Paul van der Molen** was elected as Vice President for the two years term of office (2007-2008) Congratulations!
- Mr. Jürg Kaufmann (Switzerland) was appointed as Honorary Members of FIG.
- The privilege of organizing the FIG Working Week 2011 was awarded to ONIGT of Morocco. It will be held in **Marrakech in April/May 2011**.
- The 6th FIG Regional Conference will be organised in San Jose, Costa Rica, 11-15 November 2007.
- **9 new member associations** were approved during the meetings in Munich, so the number of member associations reached 102, from 85 countries.
- **Draft Work Plan** of New Commission Chairs: The General Assembly also approved the final report of ACCO and of ten technical commissions and signed the draft work

plans of new commission chairs for 2007-2010. These work plans will be endorsed in Hong Kong in May 2007.

1.2 Technical Sessions

As generally, Commission 7 was very active during the Congress. The Commission has been involved in more than 30 technical sessions. We had joint technical sessions with other Commissions and the representatives of other international organisations too (FAO, World Bank, GSDI etc.)

Our delegates, correspondent and friends made a very hard work during the Congress. The best measure of their high-quality activities is the attendance of our technical sessions. Based on the statistics made by the rapporteurs, the number of attendants of our technical sessions is 1246 persons!

We had 180 presentations and 20 poster presentations during the Congress too. Thanks a lot for the active work.
