





"Geomatics" a new Paradigm

Geomatics comes from the French word "géomatique". Its roots are "geo" (Earth) and "informatics" (information + automation + "ics" which is the accepted form for the name of sciences). Another description of Geomatics was derived from two words <u>Geo</u>desy+Geoinformatic. In the Latin language, the Geomatics correspond to Geomatica.

The Geomatics was defined in the Oxford Dictionary as;



"Geomatics: The mathematics of the earth; the science of the collection, analysis, and interpretation of data, especially instrumental data, relating to the earth's surface".








